### Guided Walk

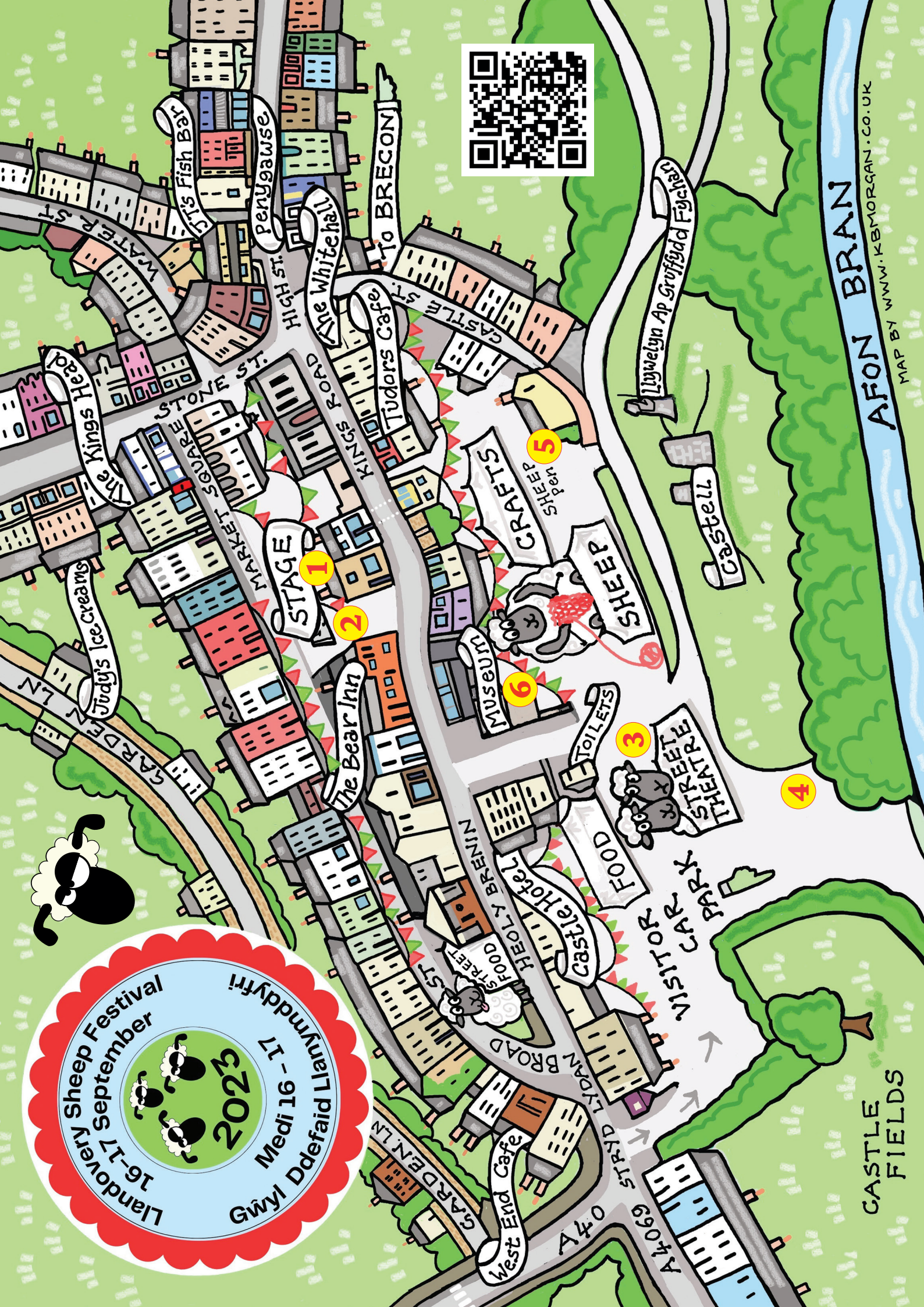

Children (over 12 only) must be accompanied by a parent/guardian. Well-behaved dogs on leads are welcome if they are calm around livestock and other dogs.
